CHURCHWARDENS ACCOUNTS  
INCLUDING POOR LAW PAYMENTS

At a Vestry held in the Parish Church of East Barnet on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1734. It was agreed for persons who were not parishioners and shall hereafter be buried in the Parish The following fees shall be paid Vis.

For every child buried in the Churchyard For the Minister Two shillings and six pence  
To the Church Warden Two shillings and six pence  
To the Clerk Two shillings and six pence  
For every man or woman buried in the Churchyard Double the same as a child  
For every person buried in a vault the same fee as if buried in the church  
Every person under 16 years of age shall be deemed as a child
